

Fin5 2022, day 1 and day 2, July 12 and 13, 2022

Complementary, preliminary competition instructions

1. Competition

**July 12, 2022 at 12.00. Day 1: long distance, WRE, Sammalisto, Orimattila.
July 13, 2022 at 11.00. Day 2: middle distance Sammalisto, Orimattila**

In all the E classes, start times are defined beforehand. In the other classes start times can be selected by competitors in a given time window.

2. Competition Centre and guidance

Navigating address: Matinniityntie 67, Orimattila.

Guidance to the competition centre:

From highway Helsinki – Lahti (E75) take road 164 towards Orimattila. Alternatively, arriving from Orimattila, take road 164. The guidance starts at road 164 at address Helsingintie 986, Orimattila.

The guidance above shall be followed as other road connections to the competition centre may go through the competition terrain and increase the risk of accidents. Also the guidance above makes your arrival smoother and quicker.

Guidance is in place from Monday July 11, 2022 from 15:00.

4. Parking instructions

Parking

Parking areas are in the farm fields close to the competition centre.

All the bigger vehicles (camper vans etc) are guided to parking P4. Other cars are guided to parking areas P1-4 from which the walking distance to the competition centre is 100-700 meters.

Any kind of camping trailer cannot be driven to the parking areas because of tight crossings and lack of space.

Note: There are no toilets in the parking areas.

Parking fees

Parking tickets are available at the Fin5 Info and that is the primary place to buy them. Parking fee is 5€/day or 20€/week. Place your parking ticket clearly visible inside your car's windscreen on the driver's side.

Payment of parking fees is also possible at the exit of the parking areas, but only cash payment is accepted there. This may cause delays when exiting parking.

Payments are controlled at the exits of parking. Parking is only allowed in the areas guided by Fin5 organizers. No parking on the roadside!

Camper vans and camping trailers

Camper vans can be driven to the parking areas. P4 is reserved for camper vans and other bigger vans. **Note: it is not allowed to drive camping trailers to the Fin5 parking areas.**

There is no possibility to stay overnight in the parking areas.

5. Maps, scales and control descriptions

The contour interval is 5 meters. The scale is 1:10,000. Classes H/D45 and older will have maps in the scale of 1:7,500

Control descriptions are printed on the maps. Separate descriptions are available only in the WRE classes H/D21E on July 12.

The maps will be of size A3 and A4 and they will be in plastic bags.

On July 12 the distance to the WRE pre-start is 2,220 m from the competition centre. Follow the red guidance / WestStar to the pre-start.

Starts 1, 2 and 3 are close to each other on both days. *Note! On the first day Start 4 is in a different direction from Starts 1-3 and on the second day it is along the guidance to Starts 1-3.*

Note! Guidances must be followed, no other routes to the starts!

Distance to the start point

The distance to the start point (K-point) where the course starts is shown in front of the map track in starts 1-3.

In start 4 the start point is in the start area.

9. Shoes

Orienteering shoes with spikes are not allowed.

10. Special instructions for WRE classes

On July 12 there is a pre-start in WRE classes H/D21E. The pre-start is closed at 12:30. Follow this timing precisely. Any arrival after that will lead to disqualification.

After passing the pre-start competitors are not allowed to come back.

At the pre-start, there is some windshield, a toilet, a water point and a possibility for warm up.

Gears and clothes placed in bags will be transported back to the competition centre.

Note that you are not allowed to bring any mobile devices or electronics to the pre-start and follow the competition or communicate with other people outside the pre-start area.

The courses in class H21E have forkings (butterflies). The competitors with even numbers take the maps and control descriptions of H21E A and the competitors with odd numbers take the maps and control descriptions of H21E B.

11. Start times, start time window

July 12: Start from 12:00, window 3 hours

July 13: Start from 11:00, window 3 hours

12. Closing of finish line

July 12: closing at 17:00.

July 13: closing at 16:00

13. Prizes, awarding

In the WRE classes H/D21E the three best competitors will be awarded once the results of the day are completed.

The winners of all the competition classes are awarded.

The prizes of day 1 can be picked up at the Fin5 Info on July 13.

The prizes of day 2 can be picked up at the Fin5 Info on July 15.

14. Water points and first aid in the competition terrain

July 12, long distance

- There are two first aid points, four water points and one control with water point. The locations are marked on the maps.

July 13, middle distance

- There is one first aid point, no water points in the terrain

First Aid

First Aid service by the Finnish Red Cross is available close to the finish line in the competition centre.

Drinking water in the competition centre

Drinking water is available in the competition centre (close to the farm house). The water comes from municipal network; please use your own bottles.

Water points on the way to the starts

Starts 1 – 3, day 1

- One point 150-350 meters before the three starts
- WRE: a water point in the pre-start area

Starts 1 - 3, day 2

- One water point in the common start area

Start 4, day 1

- Drinking water available in the competition centre, the start is located close to the centre

Start 4, day 2

- A water point on the way to the start

15. Toilets

Located in the competition centre

Toilets on the way to the starts

- Starts 1- 3; toilets located close to the starts (day 1) or in the common start area (day 2)
- WRE: a toilet in the pre-start area
- Start 4: toilets in the competition centre

16. INFO, Competition bibs

The Fin5 Info point is located in a central place in the competition centre (in a barn).

Competition bibs are available in folders next to the Fin5 Info. Please take your own safety pins to attach your bibs.

The Info and registration for open classes is located next to the Fin5 Info point.

The Fin5 Info opens at 9:30 on both days.

17. Other services in the competition centre

Catering services (food, sandwiches, sausage, coffee, soft drinks, etc) are served by two companies. Also an ice cream van offers refreshments.

Two sports stores are selling orienteering and other sports gear.

18. Washing and swimming

There is no facility for washing or showering in the competition centre.

19. Special instructions

The last control on both days is a special symbol (x) – and it is an old wooden harvesting machine.

There are some forbidden areas in the competition terrain, marked with red&white tape, and they are marked on the maps.
